



LOGIE ESTATE DRONE POLICY

While we welcome responsible drone use on Logie Estate, Operators must adhere to the conditions stated within the [UK Civil Aviation Authority Drone Code](#):

In summary, Drone Operator must:

1. Hold the necessary IDs, licences and insurances for the type of aircraft being flown. Please note, this may vary depending on size.
2. Know how to fly your drone safely and within the law.
3. Ensure the drone is fit to fly and the weather conditions are appropriate.
4. Keep the drone in direct sight and have a full view of the surrounding airspace in order to spot potential hazards.
5. Fly below 120m (400ft), the legal height limit.
6. Adhere to rules around how close you are allowed to fly to people, livestock, transport and buildings, including residential, recreational, commercial and industrial sites. You must always keep a safe distance. Please note, distance may vary depending on drone size.
7. Fly safely and never put people in danger. Do not fly over crowds of people.
8. Follow any flying restrictions, such as events, Sites of Specific Scientific Interest (SSSI), and check for hazards. Please note, the Findhorn River is a SSSI.
9. Respect people's privacy as well as the privacy of the number of commercial businesses, including farms, located on the Estate.
10. Do not share images where people are identifiable without having sought their written permission to do so, and ensure any images obtained do not break privacy laws.
